Meeting began at 7:08 PM.

Voting Results: The current board stated their willingness to continue for another term if no one else wanted to join. Treasurer's Report: The club has made a small profit overall for the year. Both the WDAA/English Dressage Clinic and Open CR clinic lost some money this year due to low attendance and a clinician airfare issue, respectively. Discussion ensued that the form for hosting/sponsoring a clinic needs to be utilized and approved before monies are granted. Timing during the year and better advertising were both proposed as areas that could use work to improve clinic turnout.

Kim Blaszak agreed to judge again, and Karen will be the secretary again. The group would also like Camille to be the photographer again - Shannon will check with her.

Awards Gala: Recommendations were for January along with being a planning meeting for the year. Exact date TBD. Damiani Wine Cellar will hopefully be the venue for this. 2025 is our 45th Anniversary for the club. Congrats!

USDF Convention: Anita Jaffe will serve as our proxy as Corrinne cannot represent two GMO's per USDF. Sending a case of wine like last year for a GMO Basket was recommended. Shannon will discuss it with Jane-Marie. Colleen made a motion not to exceed \$250 for this, Anna seconded. Motion approved.

New Business:

USDF Membership: USDF fees are going up. GMOs will go up \$1.00, PMs \$10, show fees are up. We will not be increasing our membership fees for 2025. The membership form will be edited so that money goes to Anna or PayPal while the form goes to Colleen to better streamline our process.

Advertising: Sarah P. wondered where the advertising of our clinics, etc. were done. Perhaps flyers can be made if someone would like to distribute them. FB and Instagram are unused by some/subject to the algorithm and emails and the website can get overlooked. A good discussion about advertising methods was had and it's clear that this is an area we need to work on.

Kathy asked about a possible Susanne Hamilton clinic next year, possibly in April. Sarah P., Kathy, and Shannon will look into this.
